AWARDS: \$1130 total award money including:

1. Art Appreciation Award for **best human portrait painting or an abstract painting**;
2. Award for **someone recently taking up artwork**;
3. Award for artwork **best depicting human emotion**;
4. Award for artwork **depicting the art of voting (non-partisan) and citizen participation** and 10 nonspecific awards.

2022 GAINESVILLE FINE ART ASSOCIATION JUDGED ART EXHIBIT AT OAK HAMMOCK – APPLICATION GUIDELINES

APPLICATION DUE DATE: SEPTEMBER 16, 2022

Exhibit Dates: Oct. 16, 2022 - Jan. 7, 2023; Opening Reception: Sun. Nov. 6, 3-5 PM

1. Up to 2 original art works can be submitted for consideration. Old and new artworks and art works shown prior to 2019 in the Art Gallery are eligible. Artwork shown at a previous GFAA judged show at Oak Hammock that won awards are not eligible. Judge will be selected by GFAA.

2 D ART: Any medium, framed or gallery wrapped and **must be ready for hanging by wire; sawtooth hangers are prohibited.** Unframed fiber art requires a rod and wiring for hanging. Max perimeter: 160"

STAINED GLASS: Art must be ready to hang with thin chain, wire or monofilament line. Max height: 20" and width: 30"

3 D ART FOR STANDS: The art must rest on your stable base. Max depth: 20" and height: 36", max width for base: 14", max. weight: 20 lbs. Electric outlets are nearby for selected pieces.

2. A total of \$1,130 award monies will be given out for 14 awards that include 4 specific awards: 1) **Art Appreciation Award** for best human portrait painting or an abstract painting; 2) **Award** for someone recently taking up artwork; 3) **Award** for artwork best depicting human emotion; 4) **Award** for artwork depicting the art of voting (non-partisan) and citizen participation, and 10 nonspecific awards.

2. **SUBJECT MATTER** must respect diverse views – no controversial political or religious subjects. Any display of the human figure must be artistic, in good taste, and aesthetically pleasing. Oak Hammock residents or staff portrayed in artworks will have given their permission to be included as shown.

3. **DUE DATE: Sept 16, 2022.** Submit jpegs (**preferred**), CD or prints of artwork that include artist name and titles along with completed application forms either by 1) email to jane@paintingsbyjane.com ; OR 2) regular mail to Jane Polkowski Levy, 2434 SW 50th Blvd, Gainesville, FL 32608; OR 3) leave in **THE YELLOW ART LEAGUE AT OAK HAMMOCK FOLDER BY RECEPTIONIST'S DESK IN THE LOWER COMMONS**

4. GFAA REQUIRES NONREFUNDABLE ENTRY FEE – DUE Sept. 16, 2022

*** MAKE CHECK OUT TO GFAA *** GFAA members: **\$30** for up to 2 pieces; non-GFAA members: **\$60** up to 2 pieces. Mail check to Jane Polkowski Levy, 2434 SW 50th Blvd, Gainesville, FL 32608 or place with application & images in **YELLOW folder** at reception desk at Oak Hammock.

5. You'll be notified of accepted artwork by September 26. Check-in will be on: Sun. Oct 16.

6. Provide a **signed copy of the "Artist's Release of Liability and Waiver of Claims."**

7. **Sales: There is no commission fee. All sales are handled directly by the artist.**

8. Artist bio/statement for viewers: maximum 1 page.

9. **You are requested to leave the works until the end of the show;** if an item **must be** removed earlier, contact jane@paintingsbyjane.com or call (352) 377-5979.

11. The opening reception will be Sunday, November 6, 3-5 PM in the Upper Commons.

12. Check-out/Pick up date: Sat. Jan 7, 2023, 9:00-11:30 AM unless alternate time is arranged.

ARTIST'S RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS

This Artist's Release of Liability and Waiver of Claims is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2022 by and between _____ (the "Releasor") and **Oak Hammock at The University of Florida, Inc.**, a Florida not-for-profit corporation ("Oak Hammock").

In consideration for and as a condition of having the Releasor's artwork displayed on Oak Hammock's premises and in its facility, the undersigned Releasor hereby agrees as follows:

1. Releasor acknowledges and understands that, while the members of Oak Hammock (who are not employees, representatives or agents of Oak Hammock) intend to act with reasonable diligence and care with respect to Releasor's artwork, certain risks, including, but not limited to, the risk of destruction or loss of the artwork due to negligence, unintentional or intentional acts or omissions, including, but not limited to theft, exist. Releasor also understands that there may be other risks not known to Releasor or not reasonably foreseeable at this time and that these risks cannot be eliminated. Releasor hereby agrees to assume all risks associated with the display of Releasor's artwork on Oak Hammock premises or in its facility, including, without limitation, risks caused by the negligence of others.

2. Releasor acknowledges and agrees that neither Oak Hammock, nor any of its employees, officers, directors, agents, members, residents, or affiliates (collectively referred to as the "Releasee") will be liable in any manner whatsoever for harm or damage to or theft of the artwork provided by Releasor, including, without limitation, while the artwork is in transit, in storage, on the Oak Hammock premises or in its facility, or being shown during the exhibitions. Releasor acknowledges that Releasee does not have any insurance coverage that would insure damage to the artwork provided by the Releasor.

3. Releasor voluntarily releases, discharges, waives and relinquishes any and all claims, damages, lawsuits and causes of action against Releasee and any of its assigns, successors, agents, staff, employees, members, volunteers, officers and directors for any and all loss or damage resulting to the artwork, whether caused by the negligence of Releasee and/or Releasee's staff, employees, officers, directors or otherwise. Releasor further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Releasee and its successors, agents, staff, employees, volunteers, officers and directors from any such claims, damages, lawsuits or causes of action, including, without limitation, those it might bring in breach of this Agreement.

4. Releasor understands that this Artist's Release of Liability and Waiver of Claims is a contract between Releasor and Releasee. RELEASOR HAS CAREFULLY READ THIS ARTIST'S RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND FULLY UNDERSTANDS ITS CONTENTS. RELEASOR UNDERSTANDS THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE HE/SHE IS GIVING UP VALUABLE RIGHTS.
